1. Annotate **all** texts using annotation guide.
2. **Blast:** Annotate and complete as assigned, including at least one annotated research text. Complete Blast worksheet.
3. **American Literature and History:** Read, annotate, complete online comprehension quiz.
4. **Selection Instructions**
***Selection assignments must be completed sequentially per each selection**
 - A. **First Read:** Annotate, complete all Think questions and online comprehension quiz. Complete all grammar worksheets.
 - B. **Skills Lessons:** Complete all online lessons and access 2 worksheets.
 - C. **Close Read:** Complete core vocabulary handout. Complete focus questions and writing prompt as assigned by teacher.

Extended Writing Projects:

- Unit 1: All online lessons assigned and completed.
- Units 3 and 4: ISP teacher will choose at least four online lessons for students to complete.

All completed essays must:

- Be turned in through turnitin.com.
- Use MLA format.
- Include evidence and analysis.
