Selection Requirements:

Students will:

1. Annotate **all** texts using annotation guide.
2. **Blast:** Annotate and complete as assigned, including at least two annotated research text. Complete Blast worksheet.
In addition, write a 200+ word summary of each research texts.

3. **Selection Instruction**

***Selection Assignments must be completed sequentially per each selection**

- A. **First read:** Annotate, complete assigned Think questions and online comprehension quiz.
- B. **Skill Lessons:** Complete all online lessons and access 2 worksheets.
- C. **Close Read:** complete core vocabulary handout for each selection. Chose one close read selection to assign per unit. Assign student 2 focus questions for the selection. Assign the writing prompt for the chosen selection. Use the T-Bear Rubric to grade.

Extended Writing Projects:

- Unit 1: All online lessons assigned and completed.
- Unit 3 and 4 ISP teacher will choose at least four online lessons for students to complete.

All writing assignments must:

- Be turned in through turnitin.com
- Use MLA format
- Include evidence and analysis

- Complete essay test
